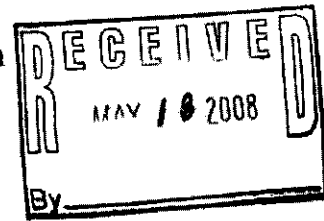

Dear Licensee:

This is in reference to your request filed on February 20, 2008 for authority to terminate the analog operations of TV station KJLA(TV), Ventura, California, pursuant to the policy set forth in the *Third Periodic DTV Review Report and Order*, 23 FCC Rcd 2994, ¶¶115-117 (2007).

After a thorough review of your request, we conclude that you have failed to demonstrate that your requested analog reduction for KJLA(TV) is directly related to the construction and operation of the station's post-transition DTV facilities, and would ensure that the station will be able to meet the DTV transition deadline. You have not shown that the termination is directly related to any of the technical circumstances cited by the Commission in the *Third Periodic DTV Review Report and Order* such as (1) stations that need to reposition their digital and analog antennas, (2) stations that need to add a third antenna, (3) stations collocated on a tower that must coordinate a termination of analog service, (4) stations with equipment currently in use with their analog operations that they plan to use with their digital facilities, or (5) stations that must terminate analog operations in order to permit another station to construct its digital facilities on the same channel. Although the Commission stated that there may be other legitimate situations that stations may cite to support a permanent termination of analog service, you simply state that termination will allow the station to avoid the cost of operating its analog facilities. We do not find that such a justification qualifies as "directly related to the construction and operation" of the station's post-transition facilities.

In light of the above, your request to terminate the analog operations of KJLA(TV), Ventura, California (File No. BSTA-20080220AAW) IS DENIED.
